Daughter and Granddaughter, Brenda & Jenna Reynolds, of KPC Board Director, Darrell Fostervold, have both been battling cancer. They have endured what many of us pray we never will face in our own lives.

Jenna is 12 years old and was diagnosed with a plastic glioma brain tumor after losing her vision during a basketball tournament on Valentine's Day, 2016. She underwent a craniotomy to remove the tumor and proceeded to live in Rochester for 3 months while undergoing Proton Beam Radiation Treatment. She enjoyed 8 months symptom free and then on Christmas Eve, 2016, Jenna's symptoms returned and she again underwent surgery. After 4 months of chemo, unfortunately her symptoms reappeared. Feeling she was strong enough to endure another surgery, Jenna's medical team removed another tumor on July 25th. Her current treatment plan includes 2 separate chemo therapies and some supportive medications. Jenna travels bi-weekly for check-ups with her oncologist at the Mayo Clinic.

Brenda is married to Troy and mother of 3 wonderful kids, Taggert, 15 and Jenna and Jorja, 12. Brenda's battle with cancer began 11 years ago and she has since beaten 13 different types of cancer. These cancers have included breast cancer, thyroid cancer, leiomyosarcoma, melanoma, Basal Cell carcinoma, kidney lesions, uterine cancer and recurrences of some which have led her to undergo 40 surgeries and she is currently awaiting the results from her recent biopsies to see what her new treatment plan will entail. Her Motto: "Do not let your battle become your identity!"

Words alone cannot express this family's gratefulness for the love and support they have received over the past 11 years. Without family, friends and community, this battle would have conquered them, but they continue to fight with a daily goal of prevailing! Thank you! We love you and will continue to draw strength from every one of you!
