

## Vestments:

In an effort to preserve some of the history of the Church of St. Patrick in Kandiyohi, parts of some of the vestments were carefully put into frames and are now hanging at the Church of St. Mary. These vestments show incredible ornate needle work. Each of the three panels depict the back portion of three of the Copes (long cloak or vestment that is open in the front and attaches with a clasp that is used for benediction and other liturgical ceremonies) that were part of the vestment collection at St. Patrick's Church. These vestments are quite old and being able to preserve them for future generations to see is a great gift. They are now hanging in the hallway next to the Conference Room at the Church of St. Mary. You are invited and encouraged to stop and see them, they are beautiful and part of our church history.


