## **Review of Area Pastoral Council and Committee Reports**

Discussion took place about our joint meeting in February. People felt very positive about the day - they weren't aware of everything that the staff does! It was also a great opportunity for the two groups to get to know each other.

We talked about the area committee reports from February, specifically focusing on their discussion about the move from the committees to teams. The committee members were mostly positive about the change.

#### **Information Items**

- 1. Lawsuits Bishop LeVoir and Msgr. Grams have worked very hard in these cases. Bishop LeVoir has met with the victims and we must continually pray for healing for the victims. The Church of St. Mary and the Church of St. Thomas More have signed retainers with attorneys, and all parish records are being combed looking for information regarding insurance coverage.
- 2. AFC Bookkeeper We have received inquiries from five people regarding the position. Father Steve and Mary will select applicants for interviewing and assuming the position is filled, they would work alongside Dennis.

3. Financial Reports - We reviewed the financial reports for March. All parishes are current on their AFC assessment and we are in good shape.

2. Consultation meetings in Kandiyohi and Lake Lillian - We discussed the meeting with Bishop LeVoir. It was felt that Bishop LeVoir was very straightforward, and using the visual of the map with all priests - and telling them that in five years we need to get rid of ten faces.
