- III. Discussion and information items:
  - A. The March Food Shelf report. There was a presentation to the Willmar Area Food Shelf in the amount of \$4,376.00 of that \$2,792.00 came from the Tithing Fund. In addition, St. Thomas More participated in the "pack the truck" in Lake Lillian. We are aware that checks were mailed directly to the WAFS.  
Suggested that we are in need of doing more PR on the March Food Drive and we need to do further evaluation for the coming year.
    1. Handouts were distributed: "Hope For Our City" about food give away every Saturday. Other opportunities of food distribution would be the produce truck that comes once a month to the WAFS. Discussion that this information should be included in the bulletin and the FIAT.
