

Baptism

Teaching:

The sacraments are encounters with Christ and Baptism is the first of these encounters. Anyone who is not already baptized can be baptized. The only prerequisite for Baptism is faith, which is professed publically at the baptism. For infants, parents profess the faith for them. At Confirmation, the baptized person confirms their faith.

What Happened at My Baptism?

- * Why did you choose to have your child baptized? Have you ever shared this with your child?
- * Why did you choose the people you did as Godparents for him/her?
- * Have you ever taken the time to share your memories of your child's baptism?
- * Do you have video, pictures, the candle, gown, certificate, or other special things from his/her baptism?



Take some time to share your memories of that special day with your child.

Baptism Soap

In the Sacrament of Baptism, we are washed clean of Original Sin and become new creations in Christ. Make [Baptism Soap](#) as a reminder of being cleansed of sin and how we become beloved daughters/sons of God.

You will need the following:

- Bar of pure soap (like Ivory) per person
- Liquid food coloring
- Vegetable Oil
- Water
- Vegetable Grater
- Bowl
- Wax or Parchment Paper
- Measuring Cup
- Optional: Essential Oil or herbs
- Soap molds or cookie cutters
