

Edible Story of Creation

Supplies needed:

Base: Graham cracker & Chocolate frosting

Day 1: Mini Oreo cookie

Day 2: Snowcaps chocolate

Day 3: Blue and green M&Ms (1 of each)

Day 4: Yellow M&Ms (3 of each)

Day 5: Swedish Fish

Day 6: Gummy Bear & Sour Patch Kid

Day 7: Mini marshmallow

For younger children, watch the video: 7 Days of Creation. For older children, read the first creation story account found in Genesis 1:1-2:3. Then do the following:

Help your child spread the chocolate frosting on the graham cracker. (The dark frosting represents the chaos that existed before creation.)

Then, retell the first story of creation, and for each day of creation, have your child(ren) add the corresponding items to the frosted graham cracker in order.



Day 1: God separated the light from the darkness (*mini Oreo cookie*).



Day 2: God separated the water above the earth (the sky) from the water below (*Snowcaps chocolates for the clouds and the earth below*).



Day 3: God separated the sea from land and made plants (*blue M&M and green M&M*).



Day 4: God created the sun, the moon, and the stars (*yellow M&Ms*).



Day 5: God created fish and birds (*mini Swedish Fish*).



Day 6: God created land animals and humans (*gummy bear and Sour Patch Kid*).



Day 7: God rested (*mini marshmallow "pillow"*).

Share how God looked at everything He had made and found it to be very good, just like all of the edible days of creation look very good!

Before eating, see if they can name the seven days of creation in order, using their graham crackers as a hint.
