For older children, read the first creation story found in [Genesis 1:1-2:3](#) (build your creation graham cracker as you read each day).

- Base: Graham cracker & Chocolate frosting
- Day 1: Mini Oreo cookie
- Day 2: Snowcaps chocolate
- Day 3: Blue & green M&Ms (1 of each)
- Day 4: Yellow M&Ms (3 of each)
- Day 5: Swedish Fish
- Day 6: Gummy Bear & Sour Patch Kid
- Day 7: Mini marshmallow

Supplies you will need: paper (black if you have it), pencil, coffee filter, blue and green food coloring.


Don't forget to talk through the discussion while you wait for it to dry!
