We are primarily a ministry of presence! We offer a listening ear, support, and a compassionate heart as we visit those who may be alone, lonely, discouraged or homebound. We can offer information about community resources to assist you in remaining in your home or in making a lifestyle transition. We provide caring people to share the life of Christ and to be the love of Christ. We do not replace pastoral visits.

We are available to visit you, a family member or a friend. We are happy to spend time with those whose family members live far away, or who could use a caring presence, or those who simply want to experience more fully our community of faith. Besides listening and sharing our presence, we can also:

- ◆ Listen to your health concerns.
- ◆ Attend medical appointments with you to help you understand what is being said and to advocate for your needs.
- ◆ Communicate health information to your family members.
- ◆ Review discharge instructions or your physician's recommendations following hospitalization.

- ◆ Identify community resources to assist you, such as transportation, housing options, food, etc.

Our ministry **cannot provide “hands -on” care or provide transportation.**
